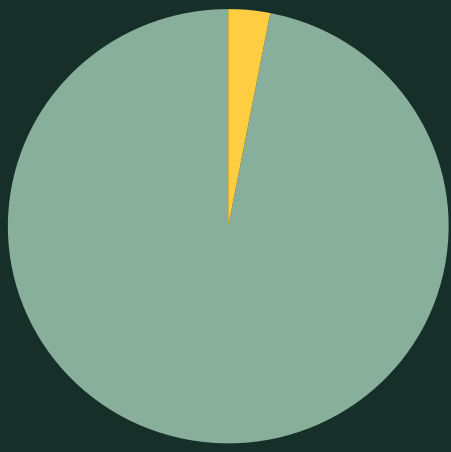

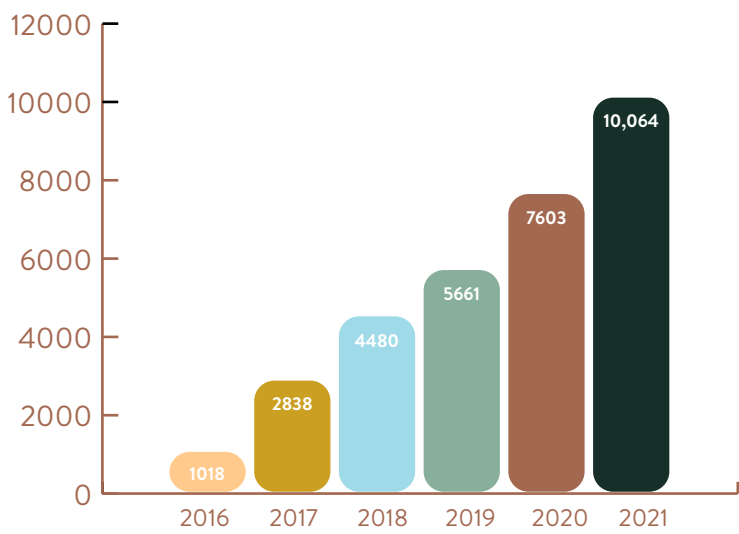

was not reasonably **FORESEEABLE.**

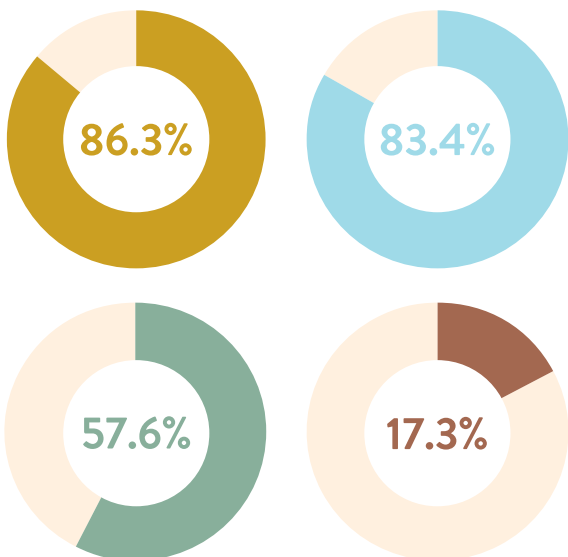


Number of Assisted Deaths 2016-2021



Reasons for Requesting Euthanasia.

The main reasons for requesting euthanasia were:



- The loss of ability to engage in meaningful activities (86.3%)
- Loss of ability to perform activities of daily living (83.4%)
- Inadequate control of pain, or concern about controlling pain (57.6%)
- Loneliness and isolation. (17.3%)**
